

BON APPÉTIT

Recipes from the Kitchen

Crab Cakes

Ingredients

- 1 lb colossal lump crabmeat
- Quarter cup small diced red yellow and green bell peppers
- One tablespoon whole grain mustard
- 2 lemons juiced
- 1 teaspoon honey
- Half teaspoon miso paste
- 2 whole eggs
- 2 tablespoons fine diced red onion
- 2 tablespoons fine diced celery
- 1 cup mixed crushed saltines and ritz crackers
- Quarter cup mayonnaise



Combine all ingredients excluding crab meat and mix well.

Once all ingredients are mixed, lightly fold in the crab so it does not break apart.

Cover and let chill for 2-4 hours.

Once chilled, form mixture into desired sized cakes. In a large sauté pan add 3 tablespoons olive oil, 1 tablespoon of butter and place in crab cakes cooked until golden brown on both sides.



REQUIRED SPENDING FAQ

The food and beverage Required Spending will begin June 1st. Below are some commonly asked questions regarding the policy.

Q: How much is the required amount to be spent?

A: In the months of June & July members are required to spend \$200 and the same for August & September, totaling \$400 per membership.

Q: Is it \$200 each month?

A: No. The \$200 is shared for the 2 month span. For example if you don't spend any of the minimum in June you can spend the whole amount in July.

Q: Can I roll my left over minimum over?

A: No.

Q: What happens if I don't spend the required amount?

A: At the end of July and/or September you would be billed the difference.

Q: What counts toward the required minimum?

A: All food, non-alcoholic and alcoholic beverages, and anything purchased in the snack bar.

Q: Can I use my minimum for special events?

A: No. Minimum can only be used for ala carte dining on course food and beverage.

On the COURSE

A Note From the Superintendent

The golf season is already upon us, and the greens maintenance staff has been busy gearing up for 2019.

If you've already been out this season, you'll notice that we've continued our bunker reconstruction project on #1, 6 & 9. The same process is being used after last year's success, and it will be a huge improvement both aesthetically and for playability. We sodded the floors again to create a barrier between the sand and any bunker base contaminants. We'll be spraying a non-selective herbicide to kill the floors the first week of May and sand will follow the week after. Once sand is installed and compacted, they will be open for play.

Trees have been removed on #3 & #12. The removals on #3 are going to open views of the back bay previously blocked, and improve the overall aesthetic. On #12, we decided to give players more than one option of how to play the hole. Good architecture is about options, and on #12, there really was only one way to play the hole. If one player hit it 200 yards and another hit it 275, they both hit it to the corner, and wedged it to the green. Now if a player hits a good shot, he is rewarded by having an option to go at the green. It's not an easy option since it's a forced carry over water, but there now more than one option. Hope everyone enjoys the changes.

We have had a few changes in the management of the greens department for 2019. Long-time Assistant Superintendent Henry Strawder, accepted a Superintendent's position at Vineyard

National. Henry will be successful and we thank him for his time at TSC. Rick Broome has taking over in the vacant position and started with us in late February. Previously Rick has been the Superintendent at Little Mill CC and Harbor Pines GC, and most recently as the assistant at Linwood CC. I've known Rick for many years, and he will be a huge benefit to both me and The Shore Club.

Look forward to seeing everyone out and enjoying the golf course in 2019.
